Step 1 Understand the Definition We need to show that for every $\epsilon > 0$ there exists a $\delta > 0$ such that if $0 < |x - 3| < \delta$ then $|x^2 - 9| < \epsilon$

Step 2 Manipulate the Expression We start with the inequality $|x^2 - 9| < \epsilon$ and factor it as $|x - 3||x + 3| < \epsilon$

Step 3 Find a Suitable δ We need to control both factors. Since x is close to 3, we can assume $|x - 3| < 1$. This implies $2 < x < 4$ and therefore $5 < x + 3 < 7$. So, we can choose $\delta = \min\{1, \frac{\epsilon}{49}\}$. Then, if $|x - 3| < \delta$, we have $|x + 3| < 7$ and $|x^2 - 9| = |x - 3||x + 3| < \delta \cdot 7 < \frac{\epsilon}{49} \cdot 7 = \epsilon$

Step 4 Conclusion We have shown that for every $\epsilon > 0$, there exists a $\delta = \min\{1, \frac{\epsilon}{49}\} > 0$ such that if $0 < |x - 3| < \delta$, then $|x^2 - 9| < \epsilon$. Therefore, $\lim_{x \rightarrow 3} x^2 = 9$.
